



(1809 - 1849)

Edgar Allan Poe was born in Boston, the son of itinerant actors. His father left his 1 wife eighteen months later and his mother died soon afterwards, so that the child was 2 3 brought up by the family of John Allan, a Scottish tobacco exporter. Poe attended the university of Virginia, left because of gambling debts, ran away to Boston and started 4 writing poetry. Having unsuccessfully tried the army and West Point, he became a hack 5 6 writer in Baltimore and, later, Philadelphia, and started editing literary magazines, an occupation at which he excelled thanks to the quality of his editorial writing and reviews. 7 His personal instability, however, made it difficult for him to stay long in one job. In 8 1835, he married his thirteen-year-old cousin Virginia Clemm. Though Poe had by then 9 gained recognition for his poem and stories, his last years were marred by his wife's 10 illness (she died of tuberculosis at the age of twenty-five), by his poverty and by his 11 own eccentricities and drinking bouts. Pictured as a depraved opium addict by his 12 detractors and as a misunderstood genius by his admirers and translators (Baudelaire 13 and Mallarmé regarded him as the precursor of the French Symbolists), Edgar Allan 14

- 1 Poe was long undervalued in America. Poe wrote three types of tales. The grotesque
- 2 tales are early, sensational stories of the bizarre and the macabre which show the
- 3 influence of German romanticism and the gothic trend. The arabesque tales focus on
- 4 the psychology of terror, exploring dreams and hallucinations, combining the natural
- 5 and the supernatural and creating further mystery by the use of unreliable narrators.
- 6 The tales of ratiocination are detective stories (Poe invented the conventions of the
- 7 genre).
