B Crater Lake:	A deep lake with a deep blue color situated in Oregon. This volcanic crater
	was formed by the collapse of a volcano 7,500 years ago.

	grizzly and black bears, caribou and moose. There aren't any reptiles and only one
	amphibian can live there: the wood frog!
