- I** *Mount Rushmore* : A **mountain** in South Dakota. There are four faces of American presidents sculpted on its side. The sculptures are 18 meters tall.
- D** *Sequoia National Park* : This park preserves giant **sequoia trees** which are among the world's largest and oldest living things.
- B** *Crater Lake* : A deep **lake** with a deep blue color situated in Oregon. This volcanic crater was formed by the collapse of a **volcano** 7,500 years ago.
- F** *Arches* : These red **sandstone arches** are situated in Utah. There are more than 2,000 natural arches in the park.
- k** *Great Sand Dunes* : They are the tallest **sand dunes** in North America and the perfect place to practice sandboarding.
- O** *Everglades* : It is a tropical **river** and a **swamp** (= *marécage*) where crocodiles and alligators live together. It is home of 40 bird species.
- A** *Denali* : It is the highest **mountain peak** in the USA. Many mammals live there such as grizzly and black bears, caribou and moose. There aren't any reptiles and only one amphibian can live there: the wood frog!
- L** *White Sands* **M** *Jean Lafitte Park* : It is named after a French pirate.
- C** *Yosemite* : This site is famous for its imposing granite mountains, **waterfalls** and **glaciers**. Half-Dome is one of Yosemite's most famous sites and well-known in the climbing world (= *le monde de l'escalade*).
- H** *Grand Canyon* : Situated in Arizona, it is one of the most spectacular **canyons** in the world. It is a 446 kilometers long **gorge** cut by the Colorado River.
- E** *Yellowstone* : This park covers parts of three states: Wyoming, Montana and Idaho. It is home of the Old Faithful, a hot-water **geyser**.
- J** *Voyageurs* : A region of lakes in northern Minnesota, along the Canadian border. Visitors can spot gray wolves and do snowshoeing in winter.
- G** *Monument Valley* : This valley of rocks is composed of a group of vast **sandstone buttes**. The valley lies in the territory of the American Indian Navajo tribe.
- N** *Mammoth Cave* : The longest **cave** in the world and explorers continue to discover passages.
